
Truths About the

1) God is its Author:

“All Scripture is inspired by God...”

2 Timothy 4:16



“knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.”

2 Peter 1:20-21



2) It is Inerrant and Infallible:

“the law of the Lord is perfect,...the testimony of the Lord is sure,...the precepts of the Lord are right,...the commandment of the Lord is pure.”

Ps. 19:7-8

3) It is Complete:

“I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God shall add to him the plagues which are written in this book; and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the tree of life and from the holy city, which are written in this book.”

4) It is Sufficient for our Every Need:

“All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.”

2 Tim. 3:16-17

5) The Bible is Effective:

“So shall My word be which goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me empty, without accomplishing what I desire, and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.”

Is. 55:11

6) The Word is Determinative:

What a person does with God's Word evidences his relationship to God Himself

John 8:47; *"He who is of God," Jesus said, "hears the words of God."*

Those who listen to God's Word and heed it give evidence that they belong to God, and those who deny and contradict His Word give evidence that they do not belong to Him.

Hebrews 4:12; *“living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit.”*




