The Method of Prayer: v.2


The Elements of Prayer:

A) Our relationship to the One we are praying to:

“Our Father”: Luke recorded the single word for father “Abba” the intimate Aramaic term used for ones earthly father. We are to come for God as we would our earthly fathers!

What does it mean to come to our heavenly Father?

- a) End our fears
- b) Settles uncertainties and gives hope
- c) Settles the matter of loneliness and rejection
- d) Settles the matter of resources



B) The residence of the
One we pray to:
Our Father “has blessed us with
every spiritual blessing in the
heavenly places in Christ”
(Eph. 1:3).

C) The reverence for the Person of God:

“ hallowed by Your Name. ”: It is to revere, honor, glorify, and obey Him as singularly perfect.



D) The reigning of God:

“Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is being done in heaven.”
