**Our Salvation is Great in what it
cost:**

It Cost Him His Home In Heaven:

Philippians 2:5-8; “Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Himself the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men; And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.”

It Cost Him Heartache:

**John 1:11; “He came to His own,
and His own did not receive
Him.”**

It Cost Him His Dignity:

Isaiah 50:6; “I gave My back to those who struck Me, and My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.”



Read Isaiah 53:1-12


2 Cor. 5:21; “For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.”

It Cost Him His Blood

“Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; to declare, I say, at this time His righteousness: that He might be just, and the justifier of him which believes in Jesus” Romans 3:24-26




Our Salvation is Great in its Scope



John 3:15; “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

Romans 10:13; “For whoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”



John 3:18; “He that believes on Him is not condemned; but he that believes not is condemned already, because he has not believed on the only begotten Son of God.”



Our Salvation is Great in its Climax



Power Over Sin:

I John 5:4-5; “For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world, our faith. Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.”

To Guide Us From the Pitfalls of Sin:
