

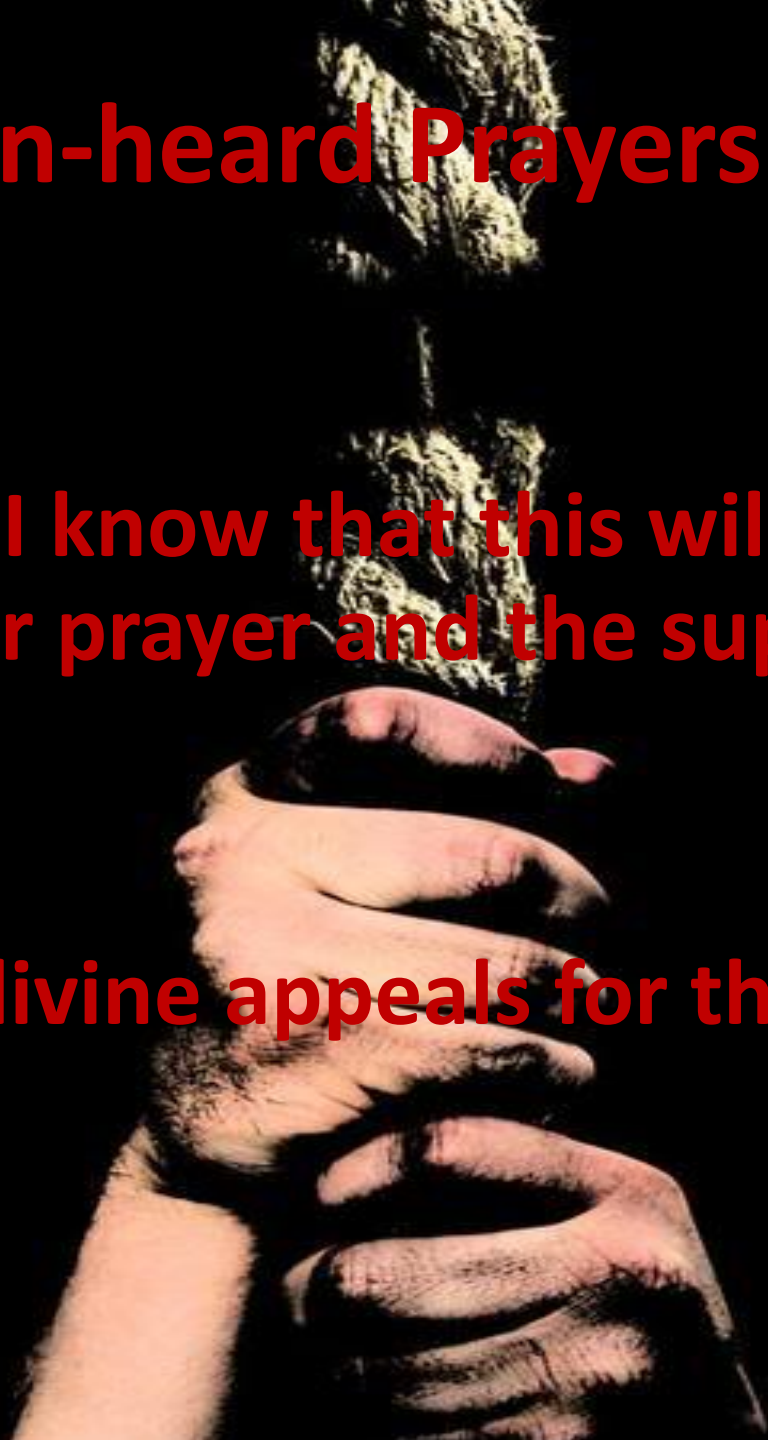


Life At The End Of Your Rope

Philippians 1:19; “For I know that this will turn out for my salvation through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ.


Groaning: these are divine appeals for the spiritual welfare of believers.






2) Rejoice in the fact that He is interested: v.27

“Searches the heart”: Our loving Savior knows and is interested in what breaks our hearts and what brings joy to our hearts.



Isaiah 61:1-3; “The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and to opening prison doors to those who are bound. To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.”



Matt. 11:28-29; “Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.”

I Peter 5:6-7; “Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.”
