“Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that in within me, bless His holy name. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His loving-kindness toward those who fear Him. As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. Just as a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him.

For He Himself know our frame; He is mindful that we are but dust.” (Ps. 103:1-5 and 11-14)

“This I recall to my mind, therefore I have hope. The Lord’s lovingkindnesses indeed never cease, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is Thy faithfulness.
