## The Arrow of Pride

Eph. 6:16

The Meaning of Pride: High opinion of one's own self or superiority: conceit: arrogance. To think that you are too good to admit that you are so bad.

## What is God's Attitude toward Pride?

Psalm 138:6; "Though the Lord in on high, yet He regards the lowly; But the proud He knows from afar."

Proverbs 6:16; "These six things the Lord hates, yes seven are an abomination to Him: A proud look..."

Proverbs 8:13; "The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way and the perverse mouth I hate." Proverbs 16:5; "Everyone who is proud in heart is an abomination to the Lord;"

18: "Pride goes before destruction and a haughty spirit before a fall."

James 4:6; "But He give more grace. Therefore He says; God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

I Peter 5:5; "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

Luke 18:9-14

1) Pride refuses to admit its need:

2) Pride won't admit it can't meet its own need: v. 11

3) Pride is more concerned with what men think rather than what God knows: v.11

4) Pride always sees the faults of other and has difficulties admitting wrong: v.11-12

5) Pride is always right

6) Pride is dogmatic, unteachable, close-minded: v.10-12 "Pharisee"

7) Pride says that none of this is me and I'm not confessing to anything.

## What is God's Attitude toward the Humble?

Isaiah 57:15; "For thus says the High and Lofty One who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble and to revive the heart of the contrite ones."

Matthew 18:4; "Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven."

James 4:6; "But gives grace to the humble."

I Peter 5:5-6; "God resists the proud; but gives grace to the humble. Therefore humble yourselves under the might hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time."
