

THE SHOES OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE

Eph. 6:15



1) We need to Remember Our
Established Relationship With
The Prince of Peace.

Eph. 2:14; “For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of division between us.”

Romans 5:1; “Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

2) The Reasons For Wearing The Shoes of Peace:

a) When we lose our sense of peace we become ungrateful with what we have.

Matt. 6:25; “therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and body more than clothing?”

b) When we lose our sense of peace we become unfaithful in our walk.

Verse 26; “Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?”

c) When we lose our sense of peace we become unfruitful.

Verse 27; “Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?”

d) When we lose our sense of peace that is when we are most unlike Christ.

Verses 31-32; “Therefore do not worry, saying, what shall we eat? Or what shall we drink? Or what shall we wear? For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.”

e) When we lose our sense of peace we go into battle unprepared.

Verses 33-34; “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.”

3) How To Rest In The Gospel of Peace:

a) Meditate on the Prince of Peace:

Isaiah 26:3; “You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.”

b) Manifest the Spirit of Peace In
Your Life:

Galatians 5:22; *“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace....”*

c) Meditate on and Memorize the Words of Peace.

Psalm 119:165; *“Great peace have those who love Your law, and nothing causes them to stumble.”*
