WHAT HE IS ABLE TO DO:

# 1. SAVE US TO THE UTTERMOST:

**HEB. 7:25;** *“Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He ever lives to make intercession for them.”*

a) Christ's ability: "He is able"

b) Salvations Nature

c) The object of salvation:

John 6:37; *“The one who come to Me I will certainly not cast out.”*

d) The Security of Salvation:

2. TO ESTABLISH THOSE WHOM  
HE SAVES IN THE TRUTH:

**ROMANS 16:25;** *“Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my gospel...”*

*John 8:31-32: "Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, if you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."*

16:13; *“However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.”*

and 17:17; *“Sanctify them by Your truth, Your word is truth.”* **(the Word)**



# 3. HELP US WHEN WE ARE TEMPTED:

**HEB. 2:18;** *“For in that He Himself hath suffered being tempted, He is able to help them that are tempted.”*

## 4. KEEP US FROM STUMBLING:

**JUDE 24;** *“Now to Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy.”*

Proverbs 3:5-8; *“Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He shall direct your paths. Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord, and depart from evil. It shall be health to your navel, and marrow to you bones.”*

## 5. MAKE ALL GRACE ABOUND TO US:

*II COR. 9:6-8; “But this I say, he which sows sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which sows bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposes in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, have an abundance for every good work.”*

## 6. PROTECT US IN EVERY CIRCUMSTANCE IN LIFE:

**DAN. 3:17;** *“If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us out of your hands, O King.”*

7. TO DO AND TO GO BEYOND ALL  
THAT WE CAN EVER HOPE FOR:

*Eph. 3:20: “Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that words in us...”*
