




**“Fulfilling the Great

Whatever it takes”**


Mark 2:1-5



When Jesus gave the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-16



“And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in Earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.” Matthew 28:18-20

that believeth and is baptized
shall be saved; but he that

It begins with

I. A desired objective (v.3)

A. “Bringing one sick...”

“Palsy” – Gk. Word –

“Paralyzed” – denotes a person
helplessness and hopeless.



**B. We must have a desire to see
those who are lost
(hopeless/helpless) come to
Jesus.**

II. A disregard for the obstacle –

(vv. 2;4)

A. “No room” – (v.2)

Overcrowded room

B. “Could not come Nigh” – (v.4)

No way in



C. Often time obstacles keep us from fulfilling God's call or plan our lives.

D. It's too hard - it takes too much time - I'm not able, etc.

III.A deliverance occurs - (v.5)

A. "Faith"

B. "Forgiveness"
